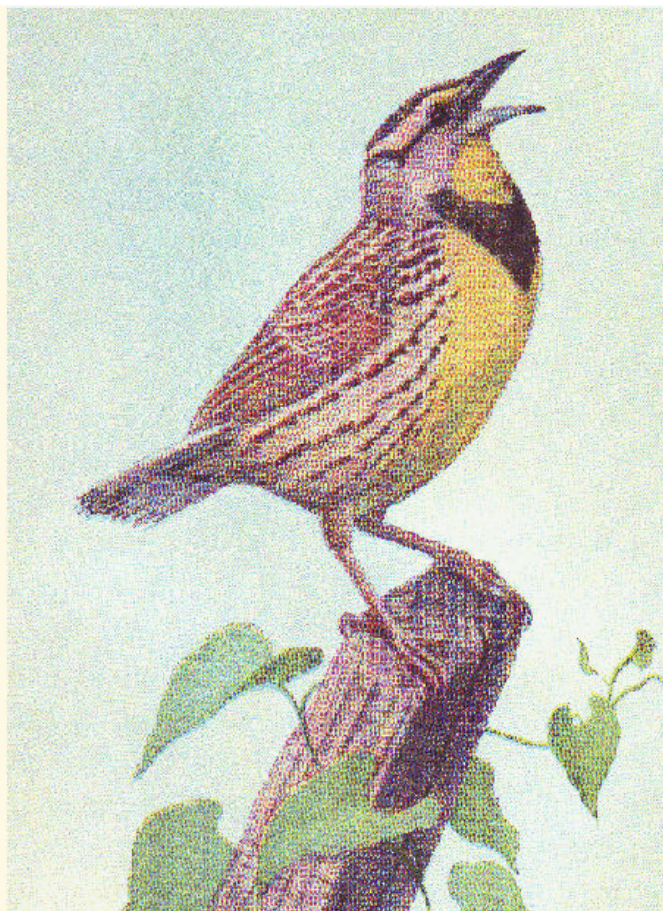


# The Burgess Bird Book for Children
